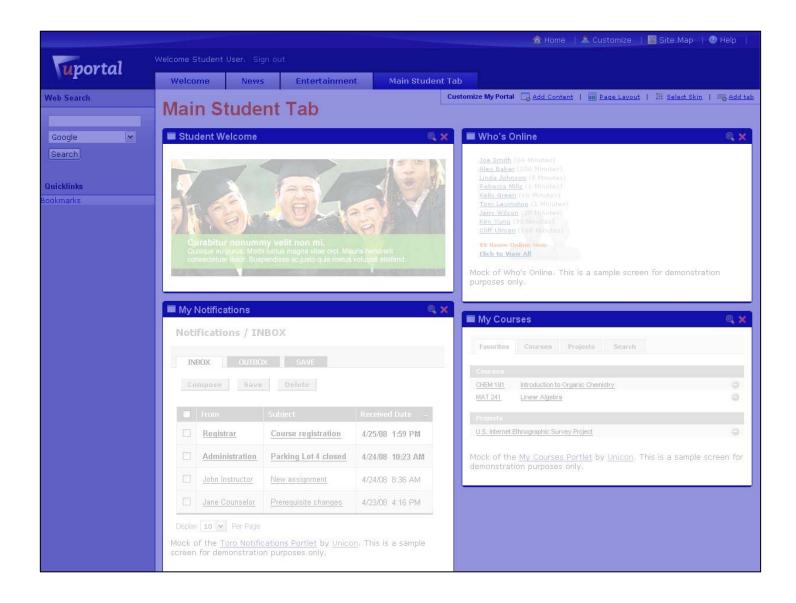
Theme

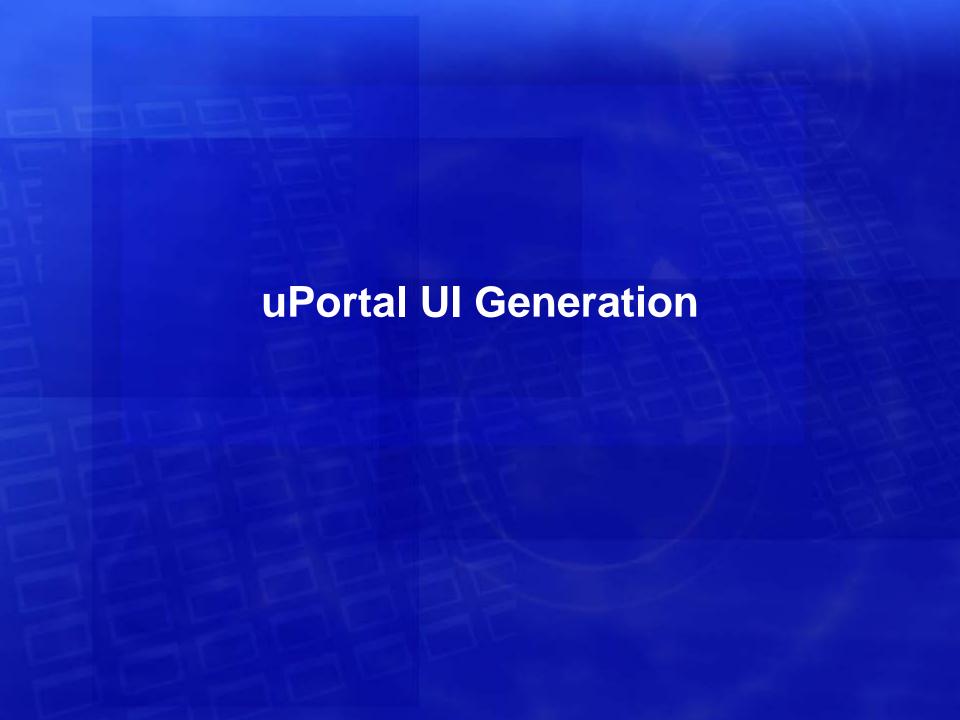
- Templates that generate page markup and user interface; everything down to and including the wrapper and controls around the channels and portlets - but excluding their contents.
- The theme does not affect channel and portlet content.



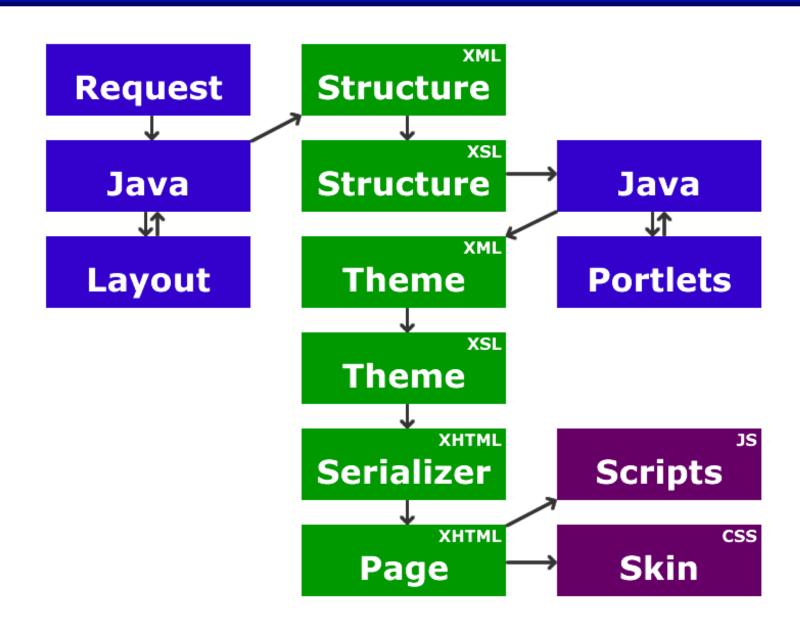
Skin

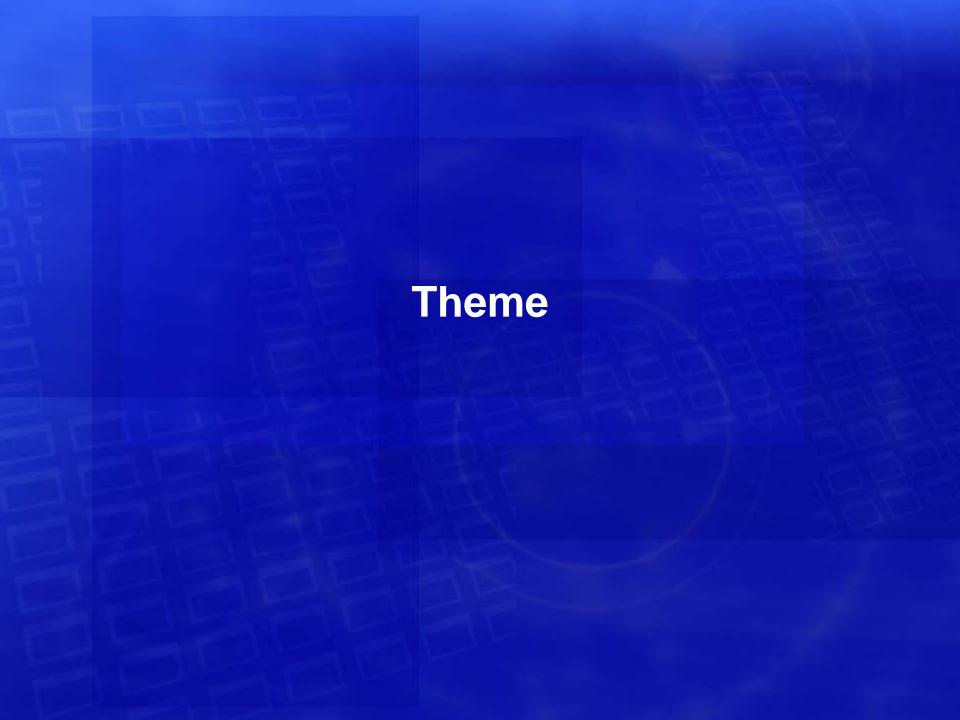
- A package of CSS and images that specify the visual presentation: color, style, type, and imagery.
- The skin does affect channel and portlet content.

- Cascading Style Sheets (CSS)
- Images





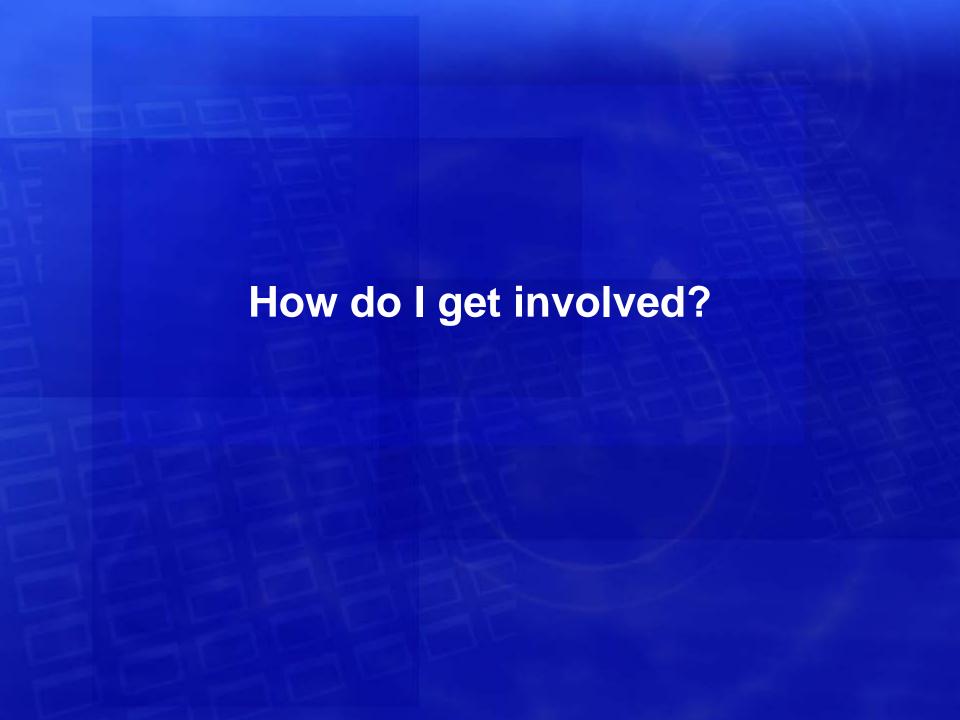
Theme Customization

- Single file (universality.xsl)
- Template calls
- Ordering
- Custom xhtml
- Localization (messages.xml)



Theme Cusomization

- Keep your customizations intact!
- Allows theme "code" to improve underneath
- Simple to upgrade
